## TESTS OFFERED

### English - CTEP

The English test measures reading and writing skills. It is composed of three sections: reading comprehension, sentence structure & grammar, and sentence & syntax skills. It is administered on the computer and is timed. Allow 1.5 hours. Actual test time is 65 minutes.

### ESL – Accuplacer

The English as a Second Language (ESL) test is for students whose native language is not English and who wish to enroll in ESL classes. The Accuplacer test is administered on the computer and is untimed. Allow 3.0 hours. The ESL test session begins with a 35-minute writing sample.

### Math - MDTP

There are 4 levels of assessment. Choose based on your comfort level. Please see sample tests to help you select the right level. The tests are administered on the computer and are timed. Allow 1 hour for the first 3 levels and 2 hours for the pre-calculus test.

- 1) Algebra Readiness - actual test time is 45 minutes
  - a. Math 20
  - b. Math 30
  - c. Math 100
- 2) Elementary Algebra - actual test time is 45 minutes
  - a. Math 100
  - b. Math 110
  - c. Math 120
- 3) Intermediate Algebra - actual test time is 45 minutes
  - a. Math 120
  - b. Math 310
  - c. Statistics 300
  - d. Math 335
- 4) Pre-Calculus- actual test time is 90 minutes.
  - a. Statistics 300
  - b. Math 335
  - c. Math 370
  - d. Math 400

### Graduation Competency for AA/AS Degree

The reading and math graduation competencies may be satisfied by completing specific courses or by passing the competency examination through the Assessment Center. Consult with your counselor to determine whether you need an examination.

### Reading - Accuplacer

The Accuplacer test is composed of reading passages followed by questions regarding the content. It is administered on the computer and is not timed. Allow 2 hours. Only two attempts are permitted district wide.

### Math - DTMS & Intermediate algebra

**You must call to make an appointment to take this test.** Two tests are available (elementary & intermediate algebra). No calculators are permitted. The tests are paper-pencil. The EA test is 30 minutes; the IA test is 60 min. A maximum of 4 attempts within a two-year period (2 times per semester, once in summer) is allowed.

### Receiving Credit for your Assessment

Students must be currently active as a FLC student (enrollment within the last 2 semesters) by either completing the online application or the supplemental enrollment form and have a student ID number. Students who applied to another Los Rios college must visit the Admissions office prior to assessment to make sure they become activated for FLC (which ensures that they receive credit for the assessment step).
