3:00-3:10	<b>Folsom Lake College – Vicky Maryatt</b> CT and MRI Program update Q and A and Industry Input	Provide update on Folsom Lake College advanced imaging programs and receive input from industry partners.	Vicki introduced Kelly Banford, from FLC, who oversees outreach and recruitment. CT program – started with 14 students, ended with 6. Unsure why so many are dropping. MRI program – started with 16, 13 are graduating in December, others to follow. New MRI program to begin in spring – 14 applicants so far. Still looking for clinical placements for students in MRI program. Finding private school Gurnick has taken many of the spots. Checking with ARRT to see why some of the exams required. Many are not seen very often, and students must perform that exam multiple times.  Will be alternating years programs are offered. Even years MRI will be offered, and odd years CT program will be offered. VI program – on hold due to lack of interest/enrollment. Has been contacted by employers interested in having their employees be trained. If enough employers contact FLC, they can host a class. Considering contract education for these employers (employer pays, students do not). Please have any interested industry partners reach out to Vicki.

3:10-3:20	<b>Yuba College – Laura Schrettner</b> Rad Tech Program Updates Q and A and Industry Input	Provide update on Yuba College RT program and receive input from industry partners.	Current enrollment 16 second year students, 25 first year students. Still looking for far north clinical sites. Have many leads and made contact yet cannot get industry partners to call back. Put in a grant for a faculty member to solicit sites and do follow-up. Still having issues finding qualified faculty. Can find techs who are interested, but not always able to teach in the academic setting. Private school (Gurnick) is absorbing many of our sites.
3:20-3:30	<b>Cosumnes River College – Dr. Faisal Hikamatjo</b> DMS Program Update Q and A and Industry Input	Provide update on Cosumnes River College DMS program and receive input and approval from industry partners.	16 current students, 13 passed physics exam on first attempt. Has reached out to many facilities for student clinical placements, only one site has responded. He has spots for 2 students, needs more. One of the challenges is that private school (Gurnick) has absorbed the sites. In need of a Medical Director. In the process of submitted their self-study report, may have a site visit in the spring. Just lost their clinical coordinator and are searching for a new one. Has asked for the team’s assistance in locating sites, new Medical Director, and faculty.
