Minimum Requirements for the Associate Degree

- Satisfactory completion of 60 semester units of degree applicable coursework with a 2.0 GPA. Folsom Lake College degree applicable courses are numbered 100 – 499
- 12 degree applicable semester units must be completed at Folsom Lake College
- **Major** – Complete a 2-year major program of study offered at Folsom Lake College with a minimum C grade in each course used for the major. ‘Pass’ grades at Folsom Lake College are acceptable
- **General Education** – Complete a minimum of 21 semester units of coursework with a 2.0 GPA from Folsom Lake College’s General Education Pattern or possess a Baccalaureate Degree or higher from a regionally accredited college or university in the United States.
- Meet Folsom Lake College’s Math, Reading and Writing **competency** requirements
- AA-T and AS-T degrees require the completion of one of the following: CSU General Education Breadth, CSU General Education Breadth for STEM, IGETC or IGETC for STEM. Please check with your counselor to determine the appropriate pattern for the AA-T or AS-T degree you wish to complete.
