

Acceptable documentation for High School Diploma
Choose only one of the following

The following must be submitted directly to the Financial Aid office:

- Copy of High School diploma
- Copy of High School transcript with graduation date, seal, and signed by school official
- Copy of GED diploma with passing test results attached
- Copy of Certificate or passing test results from:
 - California Proficiency exam (CHSPE) Certificate of Proficiency
 - Test Assessing Secondary Completion (TASC)
 - The High School Equivalency Test (HiSET)
- For California Home School: Please provide an Affidavit from the year the student graduated and Certification from the school district that the student has a valid High School Diploma (in the form of a Homeschool Transcript)
- Copy of Foreign High School diploma/transcript or Secondary School Leaving Certificate from the foreign high school, the Ministry of Education.

(Or contact the U.S. embassy in the country you traveled from to come to the USA, or that country's consulate in the United States)

* Citizenship status: victim of human trafficking, refugee, asylum, and you are not able to obtain a copy of your high school diploma contact the financial aid office.

* For Veterans only: As an alternative document you may submit a copy of DD Form 214 - Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty to verify a student's high school completion if it indicates that the individual is a high school graduate or equivalent.

The following must be submitted directly to the Admissions and Records office:

- Official **sealed** High School transcript
- Official **sealed** GED test results.

Per institutional requirements - only Official sealed High School transcripts are accepted to update your Educational Level (From GED to High School Graduate or High School to GED).
